



**“MONGOLIAN STUDIES-NEW APPROACHES”
International Scientific Conference**



The Institute for Mongolian Studies, National University of Mongolia, is announcing an international scientific conference “**MONGOLIAN STUDIES - NEW APPROACHES**” which will be held on 16-17 August, 2012 in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, in commemoration of the 850th anniversary of Chinggis Khan’s birth and the 70th anniversary of the National University of Mongolia.

Purpose:

The purpose of this conference is to address problematic issues in various fields of Mongolian studies (Mongolian society, politics, culture, economics, philosophy, history, philology and literature...) and to propose new opinions on how to solve those issues, to enhance research methods and experiences of researchers, to learn from established scientists, to cooperate with international bodies, and to implement new methods and demonstrations in scientific research projects.

Topics:

- Mongolian society and politics
- Mongolian culture and history
- Mongolian philology and literature
- Nomadic civilization

Paper Submission Requirements: The presentation must focus on an important issue in Mongolian studies, contain citations, a bibliography and an abstract in English, using size A4 paper. The presentation abstract should be printed in advance (see below). The main body of the presentation should be typed in Times New Roman, Word program, font size 12pt, line spacing –single, no more than 45 words in one line, 6-8 pages (A4 paper) and have 5-6 keywords. Any scientific transcription, hieroglyph or ideograph should be copied in same font as the presentation.

Abstract Deadline: 15th of July 2012.
