What is Global PBL?

Students from Japan and overseas partner universities working as tag teams will discuss and solve problems presented by Japanese corporations and organizations. SIT encourages students to be engaged in acquiring problem solving capabilities, systems thinking, and systems management skills through this problem solving experience.

Companies who join this program will come into contact with fresh ideas by working with these young people. This will also allow them the potential to develop human resources for their businesses.

Program outline

Number of participants: 80 students including 40 from overseas and 40 from Japan

Date: Wednesday, December 11 through Saturday, December 21

11 days 10 nights

Place: SIT Omiya Campus, Saitama Pref.

Accommodation: Hotel Metropolitan Saitama-Shintoshin, Hotel Sunvalley Nasu

(Participants will be basically accommodated in Twin Room)

Field trip: Nasu, Tochigi Pref.

Estimated expenses: About JPY 135,000 (The accommodation fee for

Saitama-Shintoshin is about 78,000JPN)

Estimated expenses include: session fee, all accommodation fee, round-trip transportation fee from Hotel Metropolitan Saitama-Shintoshin to Omiya campus, round-trip transportation fee on the field trip, and general meals for lunch and supper during your stay. *Please note that the amount is just rough estimation and especially

the fee for the meals depends on how you spend.

Scholarship: SIT Scholarship (Maximum JPY80,000)

- 3. Receive an email with letter of acceptance from SIT through the international office counselor at your university around the end of September

- 2. We will screen application documents. Applicants are NOT guaranteed acceptance into this program.
