











14–17 June 2021 Irkutsk

Topics of the Conference include the following sections:

- 1. Current climate and environmental risks.
- 2. Physics and dynamics of the atmosphere. Processes and interaction of the upper, middle and lower atmospheres.
- 3. Manifestation of geoeffective solar processes in the atmosphere and near-Earth space
- 4. Modern technologies of atmospheric and climate research and forecasting
- 5. Advanced problems of training specialists in the field of hydrometeorology and atmospheric physics

Two round tables are planned:

- 1. Advanced problems of ecology and climate in the Baikal region
- 2. Solar activity effects on weather and climate.
