Forum THNS2021, entitled "Resilient City and Transport", is to be held online between the end of October and the beginning of November, 2021.

About THNS

Forum THNS: "Transports à Haut Niveau de Service" (The International Symposium on Sustainable Development of Urban Transport Systems) was jointly initiated by Tongji University, ParisTech, and French Ministry for the Environment, Energy and the Sea in 2008. This project was encouraged by an agreement signed in 2007 between the Chinese Ministry of Housing, Urban Planning and Rural Construction and the French Ministry of Ecology, Energy, Sustainable Development and Sea, which was renewed in 2015 by the Chinese Ministry of Transportation and the French Ministry for the Ecological and Solidary Transition.

The participants of forum THNS consist of scholars, policy makers, and business representatives with expertise in urban planning and urban management, transport, public transport, rail transport, energy and the environment. As an annual forum since 2008, 12 editions of THNS have been successfully organized in China and France, with more than 1000 participants. The THNS 2015 in Paris was enlisted as one of events of the 21st United Nations Conference on Climate Change (COP21). In 2020, affected by the pandemic, THNS2020 was held online with T2M forum, and had over 200 participants from 20 countries.
