## Courses Designed Exclusively for Exchange Students at JNU

A wide range of courses are available to all exchange students, regardless of their Korean language proficiency.

- No TOPIK certification is required to enroll.
- Students with TOPIK level 3 or higher may take not only courses exclusively for exchange students but also regular undergraduate courses at JNU.

#### Intensive Korean Language Program (12 credits, 182 hours)

Basic/Intermediate level  
Listening, Reading,  
Writing, Speaking Classes



#### Getting to Know Jeju History and Culture (2 credits, Jeju history and culture theories + experiential lectures)

This course is designed for international students who have come to JNU to study the Korean language and Jeju culture. It offers both theoretical instruction and hands on experiences allowing students to learn about and directly experience Jeju's history and culture in an accessible and engaging way.

## International Student Support Center

### The International Student Support Center (ISSC):

It provides comprehensive and systematic support services to ensure that international students can enjoy a stable and successful university life at Jeju National University. A wide range of programs are offered to help students adapt to campus life, including cultural exchange support programs and academic competency enhancement programs.



### Housing

#### Type of Residence

Exchange students are typically assigned to double rooms with an en suite bathroom. Dormitory rooms do not include kitchen facilities.

#### Meals

Students may purchase a meal plan to use in the dormitory cafeteria which offers mainly Korean cuisine along with some variety of international dishes.

#### Dormitory Cost

KRW 800,000 per semester (Fees vary by dormitory building)

#### Other Miscellaneous Cost

National Health Insurance (Mandatory) KRW 80,000

Food and living expenses:

Approximately KRW 600,000- 800,000 per month

#### Nomination (Student Recommendation)

1<sup>st</sup> (Spring) Semester: By Oct 31<sup>st</sup>

2<sup>nd</sup> (Fall) Semester: By May 3<sup>rd</sup>

#### Registration

1<sup>st</sup> (Spring) Semester: November 18<sup>th</sup>

2<sup>nd</sup> (Fall) Semester: May 18<sup>th</sup>

KRW 1,800,000 per semester (program fee waived for exchange students).
