Scholarship

We will select scholarship recipients on JASSO's selection criteria for the contribution to our university's internationalization and support our students' international learning opportunities. We hope the recipients' understanding and willingness to follow the purpose of this scholarship and actively participate in our university's initiatives.

*The number of payments is determined by JASSO according to the program duration. As this may vary depending on the academic calendar, details will be provided during the application process or upon notification of the results.

- Due to the limited number of scholarships available, not all students will receive the scholarship. Selection will be based on academic performance at the home university and other relevant factors.
- Application procedures will be provided after acceptance to Saitama University has been confirmed. The tentative application schedule is as follows:
Spring intake: Applications open in December, and results will be announced around mid-March of the following year.
Fall intake: Applications will open in June, and results will be announced around late July.
- All students who meet the eligibility requirements may apply, but priority is given to students from specific universities or countries, taking into account factors such as the balance of student exchange numbers and a country's economic strength in accordance with the STEPS program policy.

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria, and scholarship recipients are required to fulfill certain obligations during their study period at Saitama University (e.g., submitting reports and participating in international exchange activities, etc.).
