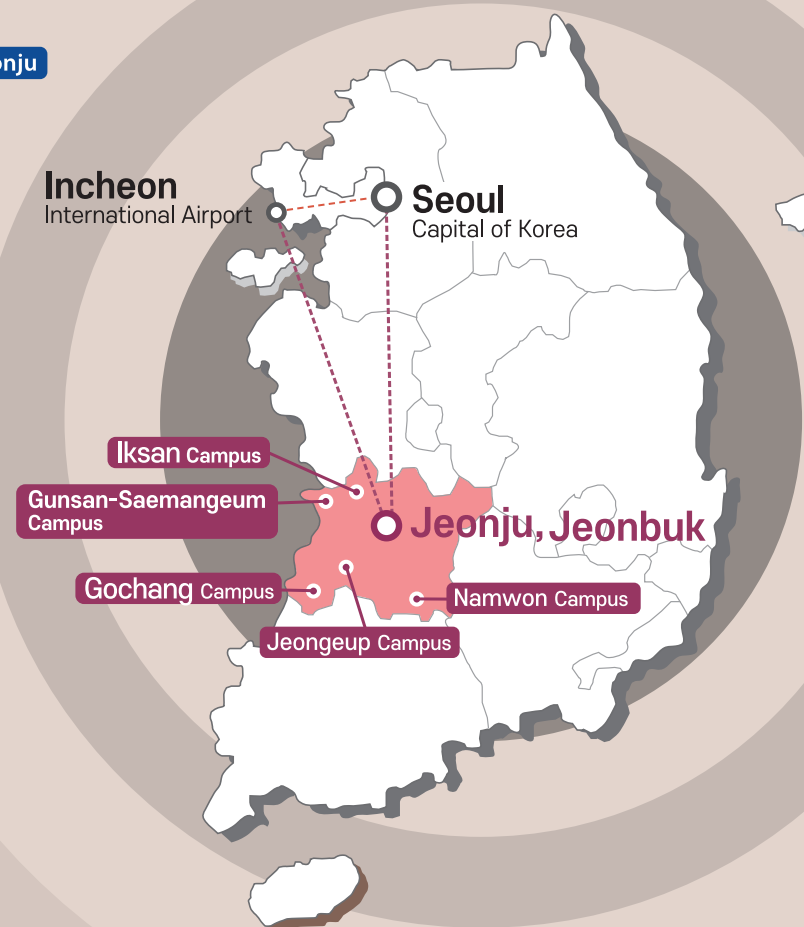

## We are investing in student education and research by attracting large-scale government-supported projects

### ‘You can’t develop great talent without a huge investment in students.’

Jeonbuk National University is working closely with local governments such as Jeonbuk State to attract large-scale talent development projects and research infrastructure construction projects.

The 200 billion won GLOCAL University project demonstrates Jeonbuk National University’s will to innovate. Through the semiconductor joint research institute construction project, semiconductor specialized university support project, agricultural and livestock microorganism industry shared infrastructure construction project, regional intelligence innovation talent training project, and advanced field innovation convergence university project, we are fostering talent that society needs.

The National University Development Project has secured a budget of 59.7 billion won over three years, including the A grade in 2023 and the highest grade, S grade, in 2024, leading to mutual growth with the region. For facility projects and maintenance for the establishment of educational research infrastructure, an average of more than 100 billion won per year, or 342.4 billion won over three years, has been secured.

### Departments for international students (Namwon Glocal Campus)

#### Department of GLOCAL Commerce

We aim to train global trade and regional economy experts who are fluent in Korean, and we pursue multidisciplinary education in management, economics, trade, and accounting. Graduates acquire qualifications related to trade, marketing, logistics, etc. and serve as a global bridge connecting Korea and their home countries.

#### Department of Korean Language

You can receive Korean language education necessary for real life and work based on an understanding of Korean society, history, culture, and systems. Also, you can acquire specialized vocabulary and practical communication skills for each industry, such as trade, interpretation, and Korean language education for foreigners, and become a multicultural, integrated Korean language expert who can work on the global stage.

#### Department of K-Entertainment

The department analyzes the production, distribution, and consumption processes of Korean popular culture and provides education that combines theory and practice. For example, by cultivating talents with practical skills related to K-pop, we cultivate professional manpower who can demonstrate their abilities in various fields such as planning companies, record companies, media, and performance planning. In addition, based on an understanding of the social context and cultural meaning of Hanryu(the Korean Wave), you can plan and develop Korean Wave content that combines traditional culture and modern popular culture.

# World-class research infrastructure Research achievements that surprised the world

Jeonbuk National University has world-class research infrastructure and research personnel.

We operate over 100 research institutes, including many world-class research institutes such as the world's fifth and Korea's first High Temperature Plasma Application Research Center, Asia's largest Infectious Disease Research Institute, and the Semiconductor Material Research Institute with a semiconductor manufacturing process system.
